Future Pathways

The Future Pathways is a voluntary employment support programme funded by GLA and ESF that provides individually tailored support for young people aged 16-24 who are not in employment, education or training (NEET) and who are from one of a number of disadvantaged groups and have one or more additional barriers in order to help them achieve sustained education or employment outcomes.







Eligibility Criteria

Residents of:

Harrow, Hillingdon, Hammersmiths and Fulham, Ealing, Hounslow, Brent and Barnet

Young Londoners aged 16 to 24 who are NEET and are:

Looked After or care leavers;

or

Homeless or at risk of being homeless;

or

- fall into two or more of the categories below:
 - lone parent
 - in problem debt (minimum of £1,000)
 - young carer
 - involved in substance misuse
 - involved in criminal activity

Exclusions:

- Young people who are receiving support through the Work and Health Programme
- Young people under 18 and in mainstream education who are currently excluded from school

- Tailored journey designed to overcome personal barriers
- Confidence & motivation building sessions
- CV's & cover letter preparation
- Job search & application coaching
- Funding to upskill
- Interview prep / Mock interviews

- Hidden job market top tips
- Financial support for first month in work
- WorkStar created and updated to monitor soft skills
- In-work support for first 6 months
