Introduction

What is on offer?

Are you interested in working within IT and computing? We are excited to be able to offer a London Borough of Brent resident a sponsorship to complete levels 1-3 Information Technology and Computing course at College North West London. The offer includes full fees covered to complete the 3 levels, to achieve a recognised ITQ qualification.

There are two possible course routes depending on your age and the course content that would be most beneficial. Each of the two routes include 3 programmes, progressing from level 1 to 3 to obtain the full Diploma for IT Users (ITQ) (QCF) or equivalent. For the successful candidate, we will discuss individual requirements with you in more detail to determine a suitable course route.

Entry requirements

An interview process will be carried out to award the sponsorship offer.

You will need English and Maths skills at entry level. However, if you do not have evidence of this, you will be given an online English and Maths assessment by College North West London if you are successful in securing the sponsorship offer. You may also be asked to complete a piece of free writing or a vocational assessment.

Bursary

The sponsorship also includes a bursary of £1,000 per term to help pay for living and course-related costs during the education period.

Who can apply?

To apply you must be a resident of the London Borough of Brent.
