Course Content and Assessment: Learners must complete and pass nine units including: *Equality, diversity and rights in health and social care *Human growth and development *Safeguarding and working in health and social care

*Psychological and sociological perspectives in health and social care. If required, Functional Skills English and maths up to Level 2.

Eligibility: Candidates must be unemployed for at least 12 months or earning less than the London living wage and resident in one of the London boroughs.

They must have basic reading and writing skills and be capable of achieving Functional Skills English at Level 2.
